OIL THEFT AND INSECURITY IN NIGERIA

BULLET POINTS DELIVERED BY DR. IBE E. KACHIKWU

TO THE GUSAU INSTITUTE CONFERENCE ON 'SECURITY IN THE GULF OF GUINEA' AT THE YAR'ADUA CENTRE, ABUJA ON 1 SEPTEMBER 2015

POINTS:

PREAMBLE: Nigeria, the world's 8th largest oil producer, is strategically important to the world and its economy. The country has witnessed, over the years, a significant loss in revenue from oil and gas due to a massive increase in crude oil theft, and disruption of production.

PROBLEMS: OIL THEFT FUELS VIOLENCE AND INSECURITY

- IT FEEDS CORRUPTION
- IT FINANCES ILLEGAL WEAPONS PURCHASES
- IT CORRUPTS YOUTHS
- IT INCREASES UNEMPLOYMENT
- IT POLLUTES THE ENVIRONMENT AND DESTABILIZES COMMUNAL LIFE.

LOSSES FROM THEFT

- BUNKERING LOSSES EST. AT 500,000 BBL/DAY
- REVENUE LOSSES EST. AT \$9 BILLION EACH YEAR.

METHODS OF THEFT

- TAPPED PIPELINES CARRY CRUDE OIL TO BARGES
- BARGES OFF-LOAD CRUDE INTO TANKERS
- TANKERS SELL CRUDE TO BLACK MARKET REFINERIES
- (NOTE: OPERATIONS ARE SOPHISTICATED, OFTEN COORDINATED WITH MILITANT ATTACKS.)

PROPOSED SOLUTION: LOCAL HUMAN/COMMUNITY SUPPORT

(NNPC: 5,000 PIPELINE NETWORK ACROSS NIGERIA)

THROUGH HIGHLY SOPHISTICATED SURVEILLANCE SYSTEMS

- a. Airborne elements fixed wing, surveillance aircraft provide accurate, real time targeting analysis and vectoring data, flying along the coast and rivers and locating smuggling vessels.
- b. UAVs (Unmanned Airborne Vehicles) DRONES.

- c. Command and Control Elements.
- d. Maritime and Land Security Forces. Conducting board, search and secure against targeted vessels.

MY MAIN OBJECTIVE:

- TO CREATE A PHYSICAL SECURITY PROGRAM THAT LIMITS LOSSES AND DAMAGE TO OIL FACILITIES THAT PROVIDES A MEANS TO COUNTER AND DEFEAT THREATS ON A SUSTAINED BASIS.
- TO CREATE A SAFE ENVIRONMENT FOR ALL OIL FIELD PERSONNEL AND THE LOCAL POPULACE.
- BRING THE FIELD BACK INTO PRODUCTION AND SECURE A CONTINUOUS PRODUCT FLOW TO NNPC AND ITS PARTNERS.
- TO REDUCE VIOLENCE, KIDNAPPINGS.
- TO SIGNIFICANTLY INCREASE OIL AND GAS OUTPUT AND UNINTERRUPTED TRANSPORTATION TO DESTINATIONS, REFINERIES, LOADING STATIONS, ETC.
